The language of the course:

All lectures are offered in English. Translation could be offered according to the request into Russian and Chinese by qualified interpreters.

Other languages must be clarified according to their possibilities. This also concerns the German language.

The Supervised Practice of 140 hours minimum serves the own experience with the Montessori material. Supervised Practice will be included in the course schedule.

Observation practice of 90 hours and Teaching Practice of 80-120 hours in a Montessori Kindergarten is required. The place and the time must be organized independently by the student.
