Visit of the Montessori-Kindergarten

It may seem unusual when I start my daughter Maria Christina's activities in the Montessori area with the fact that she has already absorbed life in a Montessori Kindergarten prenatally. After her birth, it was not possible to come home to my private apartment, because the bilingual Montessori kindergarten is on the ground floor. As soon as the front door was opened, the children in the kindergarten were very happy and welcomed me with the baby. She lived with the Montessori Kindergarten from that day until she was 6 when she started school. She was very knowledgeable and has often given help to other children. After class at school, she continued to attend kindergarten every day because all the children were expecting her. She spoke to the children and listened to them very often.

Finally Maria was able to come back to kindergarten every day. She did the internship that was part of the state teacher training.

AMI Montessori Special Education course under the direction of “Aktion Sonnenschein Help for the multiple and differently disabled child e.V.”






*Workshop Practical Life with

A new organization had to be founded to sponsor the Montessori Kindergarten so that the Bavarian state and the city of Munich could give grants.

The kindergarten was run privately for almost 20 years without subsidies because it was not "normal" to work bilingually.





“**Montessori Internationales Ausbildungszentrum e.V.**” (MIA) from 1998 for the sponsorship of the Montessori-Kindergarten and the AMI Course.

- Maria contributed to the establishment, which became necessary because I ended my collaboration with Aktion Sonnenschein on the advice of Renilde Montessori and had to found a new organization in order to be able to continue giving AMI courses. The kindergarten was assigned to this organization and the course was also added.
- Maria took over the preparation of the room. The course was initially held in the kindergarten rooms. At the age of 12 she listened to every event in this first course. Unfortunately I didn't let her take the exam because I thought she was too young!
- During this time, Maria attended the course again at the age of 20/21 years, fulfilled all the requirements and in 2007 she received the AMI diploma for 3 -6 years.
- She helped prepare the documents for the written and oral exams.
- From this point on, she worked on the exam as a “child” / assistant / witness or liason person. At this time she also worked with Hilla Patel as an examiner and got to know various AMI External Examiners. Hilla recommended Maria to sign up for trainer training. Unfortunately, she did not have a university degree. This requirement has now been clarified.
- She read and evaluated written examination papers under my guidance so that she knew which criteria I use as a basis for the assessment.

Under this organization, Peter Gebhardt-Seele, AMI Elementary Trainer, gave the first AMI teacher course in Munich in 1999, in the rooms of our kindergarten until we got the place at BMW. Maria helped with the organization again and, under the guidance of Peter Gebhardt-Seele, prepared the materials for the teacher’s course, both in the 1st and 2nd Elementary course.

In 2015 Maria took over the board of directors of the MIA association and the cooperation between the Kindergarten and the course were guaranteed.



Events of personal responsibility

- She was invited as a speaker at the Montessori Congress in Poznan / Poland, organized by the AMI Montessori Center.
- Graduation lecture in the AMI course after she became CEO under MIA.
